WMU GENERAL MEETING

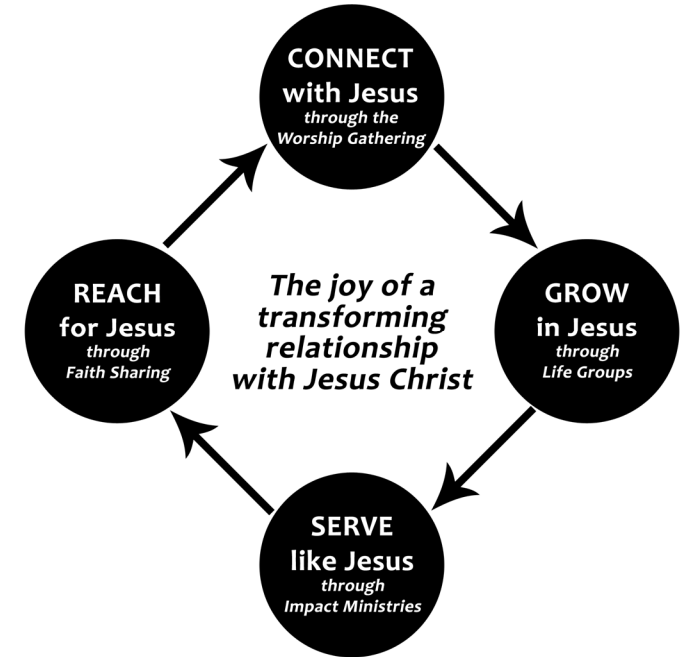
