SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED!

**Our church has a special ministry to the Doris Henderson
Newcomers School.**

The Open Door Class, taught by Lina Morris, participates in a
Backpack Ministry with the school. They provide food for a
number of students to take home every week during the school
year. They bring food to a special room here, come in to pack it
every week, and take it to the school. This is much appreciated!

Every August, our entire church is invited to bring school supplies
for students, who are in Grades 3 through 12. As you may know,
their students come from many different countries around the
world, and about 98% of students at this school live at the
poverty level. Many of our Karen children have been students
there, and others will be. Students stay for one year, in order to
learn to speak English, so that they can adapt to life in other
schools. Many of these students have come to the United States
from countries where they were persecuted. They need our help!

**As the school supply sales begin, will you please purchase
items we can give to the Doris Henderson Newcomers
School? You can bring these to Doris Henderson's office,
and she will take them to the school.** They can use all sort of
school supplies (backpacks, pencils, notebooks, composition
books, erasers, crayons, color markers, notebook paper, etc.).

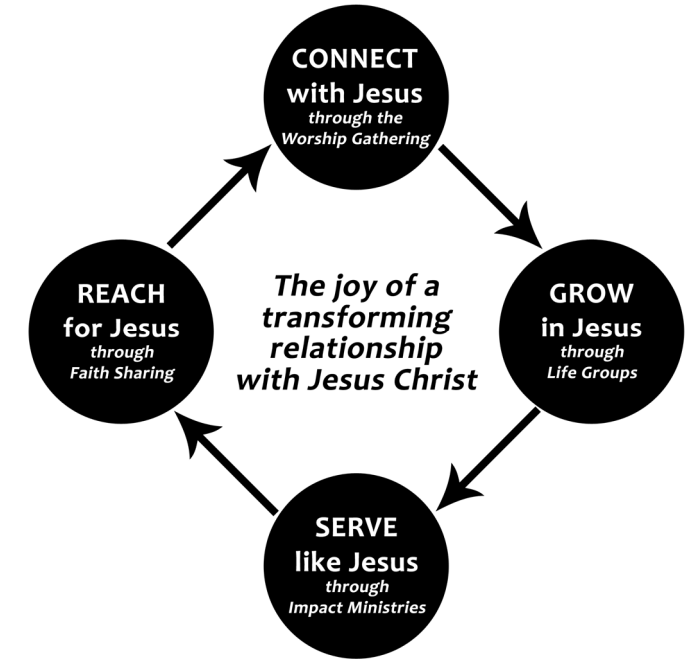
